Uses: The uses of top performing ASCEND Perennial Ryegrass are endless due to the speed of establishment, dark green color and, low growing characteristics. ASCEND will do an excellent job in either new construction or over-seeding, especially when compared to mixes using common or lower performing types. Contractors and municipalities, and professional turf managers can receive excellent performance at a good value. In southern areas, ASCEND perennial ryegrass is used for over-seeding warm season turf grasses for cool season turf performance.

Geographical Adaptation: From the northern portion of the transition zone, north throughout the cool season turfgrass zone. Perennial ryegrass is equally at home over seeded into Bermudagrass for beautiful winter turf in southern climates.

Features: ASCEND achieved the top performance group rating of all perennial ryegrasses for fairway turf quality in the most recent turf trials. Low growing, dense and dark green. Excellent mowing qualities. ASCEND continues to rank high in grey leaf spot testing. Unlike older varieties, ASCEND's growth is focused on lateral rather than upright thereby reducing mowing and more closely matching the growth habit of Kentucky bluegrass.
