"Strong" Creeping Red Fescue

Uses: BADGER is adapted for use in high quality sun and shade mixes. Its fine texture and rhizomatous spreading habit make it an excellent choice to add a recuperative quality to fine fescue mixes. Much better color, persistence, wear tolerance and density than common creeping red fescue. Can be used at 15–35% in general cool season mixes with named bluegrasses and improved perennial ryegrasses.

Geographical Adaptation: Best from the northern third of the transition zone and North. Can be utilized in many northern areas of the prairie, the Intermountain States as well as the Pacific Coast states.

Features: BADGER exhibits Fine texture, drought tolerance, and spreading quality in sun or shade. A top performer, BADGER is a staple in shade and lower maintenance mixes. Additionally, it is tolerant of several diseases which can decimate Common Creeping Red Fescue.
