Uses: A valuable choice for over seeding and new construction of premium Bluegrass with moderate cost. GOLDRUSH can be used as a dense, attractive first cut rough component to contrast Bentgrass fairways. This is an excellent choice for over seeding of moderate to high maintenance Bluegrass athletic fields, commercial turf, lawns and golf course roughs. When used in a program of high fertility and managed soil P.H., it will spread and withstand wear, traffic and mechanical damage. Mix with fine fescues and or perennial ryegrasses in cooler climates and at the rate of 5–20% with turf type tall fescue in transition zone for added sod strength and wear tolerance. As a “BVMG type”, GOLDRUSH can facilitate genetic breadth in bluegrass blends by using 3 or 4 “types” as grouped by Rutgers University in yearly updated categories.

Geographical Adaptation: GOLDRUSH will thrive throughout the range of Kentucky bluegrasses adaptation. It has adaptability in the Northern quarter of the transition zone under appropriate management.

Features: GOLDRUSH features density, and offers rhizomatous repair of damaged areas for the customer who unquestionably wants the highest quality obtainable.
