Uses: SHADOW II is adapted for use in high quality sun and shade mixes. Its fine texture and vigorous growth make it an excellent component for most fine fescue mixes.

Geographical Adaptation: Best from the northern third of the transition zone and North. Can be utilized in many northern areas of the prairie, the Intermountain States as well as the Pacific Coast states.

Features: The No. 1 Fine Fescue in the NTEP-2001 data. In the 1993–1997 NTEP Fine Fescue trial, SHADOW II rated: The #1 overall fine fescue, #1 Fine fescue in full sun, #1 fine fescue in drought, #1 Chewings fescue for leaf texture and density, and #2 in shade trials. Very Good winter color and shade tolerance, fine texture, good spring green up, and disease resistance makes Shadow II an excellent component for mixing with Scotts/Landmark's other top performing varieties including our leading Kentucky bluegrasses, perennial ryegrasses, as well as hard, creeping red, and sheeps fescue.
